## Directions

From St. Louis:

Take I-70 west 13.8 mi. from I-270 to the T.R. Hughes/Belleau Creek Rd. Exit # 219.

Turn left (south) off the exit onto Belleau Creek Rd. Go 1.1 mi. to the High School parking lot on your left just before the Mexico Rd. Intersection.

Enter the Building via the West entrance (two sets of Double doors) next to the flag pole and the "Fort Zumwalt South High" lettering on the Building.

Alternative from North St. Louis County:
