1/2 cup of ammonia

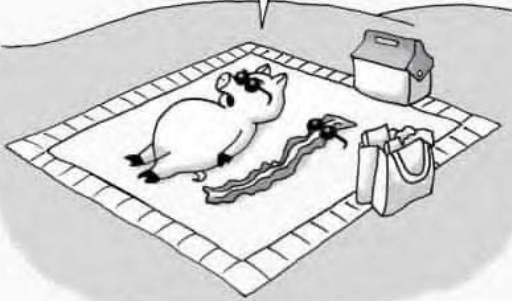
1 cup rubbing alcohol

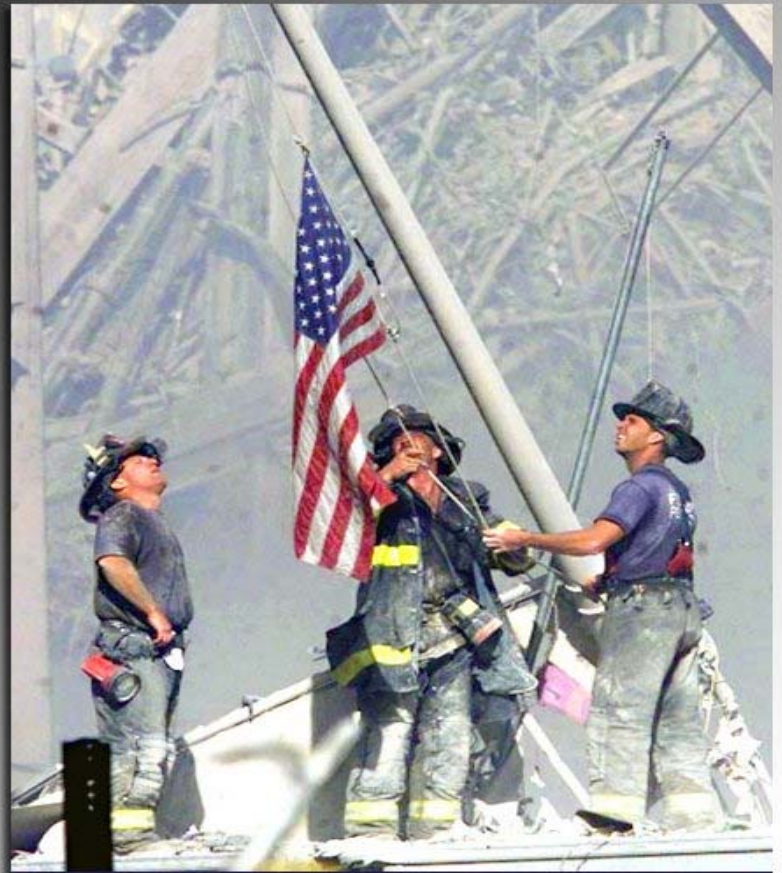
